

In today's Scripture verse, it doesn't say Jesus wouldn't do any miracles; it says He couldn't. God moves and works where there is an attitude of faith. How many times do we stop God from abundantly blessing our lives because we don't believe His promises are going to happen? We let our current circumstances and what's happened in the past talk us out of it.
