

The Scripture says, "Your Father sends rain on the just and on the unjust." Being a person of faith doesn't exempt you from difficulties in this life. Jesus told a parable about a wise man who built his house on a rock. This man honoured God. Another man foolishly built his house on the sand. He didn't honour God. Then the rain descended, the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on the houses of both the just and the unjust. But after the storm was over, the house built on the rock was still standing. The house built on the sand was completely ruined.

You may get knocked down and go through some dark, stormy times, but that's just a part of life. It 'rains' on everybody. The difference is that when you honour God, when you stay in faith, you have God's promise that when the 'storm' clears, you won't be the victim; you'll be the victor. You will still be standing.
