

When James says “you ask amiss”, the word “amiss” means “sick, weak, miserable”. When we ask to just get by and endure, that’s a weak prayer. That’s asking amiss. God is saying, “I created the entire Universe. Don’t come to Me with a weak prayer, asking Me to help you live in mediocrity. Ask big, knowing that I am the God of more than enough. Ask Me to reveal Myself in your life, to heal you from that sickness / disease, to accelerate your goals, hopes and dreams.”

When you ask big, God calls that a healthy prayer. That is when He says to the angels, “Go to work. Release My favour. Open new doors.” Ask to be the difference-maker. Ask to set a new standard. When you truly release your faith, it allows God to do great things in your life.
