

According to the Word of God, we resist Satan not by focusing on resisting him, but by being established in *the faith* that we are made right with God through Jesus' blood, and that we are thereby the righteousness of God in Christ. (2 Corinthians 5:21)

Yes, Satan will continue to remind you of your mistakes, failures and sins. He will tell you that because of these things, you cannot receive your healing, that you will have to pay for your mistakes, or that something bad will happen to you or your family. He will accuse you, condemn you and try to get you to believe that he can do bad things to you. However, the truth is that Satan cannot enforce anything in your life if he cannot persuade your soul and spirit. He cannot do so if they are "steadfast in the faith", if they are established in righteousness. God says that once you are established in righteousness, "You shall be far from oppression, for you shall not fear; and from terror, for it shall not come near you." (Isaiah 54:14)

So you can boldly declare, "Yes, I may have these problems in my life, but I am not guilty in God's eyes. I am justified in God's eyes by faith because of what Christ has done. I am righteous by Jesus' blood!" That is how you resist Satan and become undeavourable!

1 Peter 5:8-9 "Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary Satan walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour. Resist him, steadfast in the faith..."
