With chains on both wrists, Peter was guarded by four squads of soldiers to make sure he didn't escape. Today's Scripture says the church was constantly in prayer for Peter, asking God to somehow bring him out. While they were praying in the middle of the night, an angel showed up in the prison and woke Peter up. He was sleeping, not praying, but he had friends who were praying. The chains fell off Peter's wrists, and they walked past two guard posts and the prison's iron gate opened of its own accord. Peter's life was spared.
