

In the Jewish community, the promise, “Blessed shall you be when you come in, and blessed shall you be when you go out”, refers to being blessed in the affairs of one’s daily life, whether in or outside one’s home.

So, in today’s Scripture verse God is saying that you are blessed in every area of your everyday life. Psalm 68:19 says, “Blessed be the Lord, who *daily loads us with benefits*, the God of our salvation!” Because God’s Word says so, believe that every day of your life is loaded with benefits. Every morning, when you get up, believe that it is a day that the Lord has made, and rejoice and be glad in it. (Psalm 118:24) Start the day expecting it to be loaded with the benefits that God has prepared just for you. At night, when it is time to sleep, know that you will be blessed when you get up in the morning because there will be another load of benefits from your Heavenly Father, who so loves you unconditionally, waiting for you.

You can’t make your blessings happen, but if you will just believe what God has said in His Word and act like it is so, the blessings will manifest in your life. In fact, God wants to bless you more than you want to be blessed!
