

One day when Joshua and the Israelite army were fighting a battle late in the day, he knew he wasn't going to be able to finish the enemy off unless he had more daylight. He could have thought: "Too bad. They will escape in the night." No, he knew he was heavy with God's favour, so he prayed a bold prayer: "Sun, stand still." The Scripture says the sun stopped, and didn't go down until Joshua had completely defeated the enemy.

Are you praying bold prayers, expecting God to show out in your life? It may not look logical or possible, but God is for you, so ask in spite of what the enemy keeps whispering in your ears. If you are going to reach your highest potential, you need to learn this principle of asking big.
