

Of all the words God could have chosen to call this beautiful meal, holy Communion, He chose the word *Communion*. Pursue the blesser and not just the blessing. When you have Him, you have everything.

The journey that Jesus undertook with two of His disciples to Emmaus took place the same day He rose bodily from the grave. What was so important to the Lord that He would do it on the day of His resurrection? The resurrected Christ did this: "Beginning at Moses and all the Prophets, He expounded to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning Himself." (Luke 24:27) Later the two disciples said to each other: "Did not our hearts burn within us while He talked with us on the road, and while He opened the Scriptures to us?" (Luke 24:32)

As a believer, continue on your own personal spiritual journey, as you see Jesus in the Scriptures and experience His deep, personal love for you. Feel Jesus *Himself* drawing near to you, lavishing His love on you, and imparting to you all you need.
