

When a blind beggar named Bartimaeus heard that Jesus was passing by, he started to shout: "Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!" Technically, Jesus was the son of Joseph and Mary. Bartimaeus called him the Son of David, which was the Old Testament Messianic title, because he recognized Jesus as the Messiah. When he cried out to Jesus, he was saying: "You are my Messiah, my Deliverer, my Healer, the Most High God. Have mercy on me!" Jesus stopped in His tracks, and would have thought: "Here is someone who knows who I am, someone who believes I have all power, someone who is expecting My goodness. His faith is authentic."

When Jesus healed Bartimaeus, He said what He is also saying to you: "Your faith has made you whole." So know that your faith is going to turn things around, open the right doors, and bring unexpected favour. Remain expectant. God is passing by. Release your faith. It is going to happen sooner than you think.
