When Pharaoh told his foremen to have the Israelites make the same amount of bricks without the hay and straw being provided for them, they in all likelihood prayed: "God, please help us to find the supplies that we need." They prayed from a slave mentality, from a limited mind-set. Instead of asking to be freed from their oppressors, they were asking to become better slaves. Instead of praying for what God promised them, they prayed that God would help them function better in their dysfunction.

Are you asking to become a better slave, or are you asking for the more-than-enough life that God has for you? Take the limits off God and ask big. Ask God to help you think bigger and better, so that you can live better.
