He was promoted out of season, even though he didn't have the qualifications. David didn't know that God was about to do something extraordinary. Neither he nor Sarah was "in season".

Every circumstance in your life may indicate it's not your season. There is no sign of a relationship getting better, of you being promoted, of your health improving etc. You are thinking to yourself: "It's never going to change." Don't believe Satan's lies. God is saying: "I'm about to bless you out of season, and surprise you with My favour. It's going to be bigger, better, and more fulfilling than you have hoped and dreamed." Remember, we serve a supernatural God. Don't complain because you are out of season, because you are actually in prime position for God to show out in your life.
