This is how the Israelites felt in Numbers 21. In the hot, barren desert and desperate for water, they came upon an old, dry well. When it looked impossible, instead of complaining, they began to sing: "Spring up, O well!" They were making a declaration of faith. They "all" sang "to" the well of promise, over and over. That was the key. Suddenly, water began to flow.

There are promises God has put in you. Your circumstances may say: "It's not going to happen." You need to do as they did, and sing to the promise. Your praise, your thanksgiving, and your declaration of faith (remember, faith is the opposite of fear) are what cause healing, abundance, and breakthroughs to spring up.
