He understood the principle that everything he was experiencing was serving God's Plan, including the bad breaks and unfair things. After Joseph interpreted Pharaoh's dream and was made Prime Minister of Egypt, he even declared that the very harm his brothers meant for him was instrumental and necessary to getting him to the throne, and his destiny of saving their lives.

Are you upset about something that is actually serving God's Plan? God will use people who are against you to move you into your purpose. God uses the bad breaks, the delays, the setbacks, and the injustices to move you into your destiny. The things you don't like, and the things that are taking longer than you thought, are serving His Plan. Keep reminding yourself that it is not working against you; it is working for you. It will lead you to new levels.
