Don't go behind their back and start sowing discord, bad-mouthing them and trying to get others on your side.

Are you letting certain people sow discord in your life, causing you to be bitter, discontent, and jealous toward others? Don't sit there inactive while they try to convince you of everything that is wrong with your workplace, with your spouse, or with your life. Disconnect from these toxic people, and don't let their poison into your soul and spirit. You need to be bold and say: "No, that is not for me." Don't get on Korah's side; stay on God's side.
