

In today's Scripture verse, the word "goodness" means God's favour. David was saying: "Surely favour follows me all my life." In effect, he was saying: "Favour is keeping enemies from defeating me. Favour is bringing promotion and opportunity." He didn't just think about it. He spoke favour over his life. He was releasing his faith for the favour of God. No wonder the prophet Samuel came to him and anointed him as the next king. No wonder he defeated a giant twice his size. No wonder King Saul couldn't kill him.

You can increase in favour. When you are constantly talking about the favour of God, and highlighting His goodness, you will go places you couldn't go on your own. You will overcome obstacles that seem impossible. If, for example, you are struggling in your finances, start declaring: "The favour of God is bringing increase and promotion. Favour is opening doors that I cannot open." The more you thank God for it, the more you declare it, the more favour you are going to see.
