

After Moses received the Ten Commandments on the mountain, he discovered the Israelites worshipping a calf made out of gold. He was furious, knowing that God was about to bring judgement upon them. When Moses called to the people: "Who is on the Lord's side?", the sons of Levi took a stand and did the right thing.
