

A servant of Christ needs to be diligent. Diligence is not busyness, but rather a way of seeking daily what the Lord wants us to do. He gives us new opportunities to serve Him every day. Psalm 68:19 says: "Blessed be the Lord, who daily loads us with benefits." One of those benefits is meaningfulness - a set of goals, purposes and assignments for each day.

The Early Church functioned seven days a week: "So continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, they ate their food with gladness and simplicity of heart." Remember, a believer who regards everything as a burden cannot be a faithful servant of the Lord.
