

One of Jesus' most well-known teachings is on worry over provisions. (Matthew 6:25-34) The teaching is summarized near the end with the admonition to "seek first the Kingdom of God...", and all that we need will be provided. (Matthew 6:33) But in Luke's version of the same teaching, an additional insight from Jesus is recorded: "Your Father has chosen to give you the Kingdom." (Luke 12:32) We have been made participants in God's Kingdom and all its resources, yet we often find ourselves worrying about daily provisions. Pursuing what we already have (God's Kingdom), leads us to find what we need.
