

The three women who went to the tomb on Sunday morning to care for Jesus' body were met by the angel's question: "Don't you remember what He told you?" They came to the tomb discouraged, depressed, and defeated, and they left excited, passionate, full of faith and hope. They couldn't wait to tell the disciples. Remembering what God says will change your perspective.

When we are under pressure, under stress, overwhelmed by a situation, too often we forget what God has said, and we go by what we see and feel. We let negative thoughts drown out what God has promised. Recognize that it's a test. The enemy would love for you to get so caught up in your circumstances that you forget what God told you. Are you remembering that He says He will supply all your needs according to His riches? Are you remembering that He says greater is He who is in you than he that is in the world trying to stop you? It is not complicated. Keep remembering what He has spoken over you.
