

When Job and his wife went through a series of very painful losses, and then Job suffered a crushing illness, instead of encouraging Job, she said: "Job, you have always done the right thing, and see what you get. Just curse God and give up." Fortunately, even though he didn't understand why it had happened, Job knew better than to make judgements based on one season of his life. He declared that God's favour had been on his life, and that this 'storm' was not permanent. By faith, Job weathered the great 'storm' and eventually came out of it with double and lived a long, blessed life.

Every believer goes through unfair, painful seasons. But you need to remind yourself that it is just a season. It is not for the rest of your life. Don't make a judgement based on a betrayal or a setback that is temporary. Don't give up on your hopes, dreams, lose your passion, or live bitter. The 'storm' may be difficult, but what God is about to do is going to supersede anything you have ever seen.
