

The Israelites had been in slavery in Egypt for 400 years. God sent plagues on Pharaoh until he finally let them go. You need to rise up and say: "I am no longer a slave, I am a son / daughter. I am not a slave to my past, to the people who took advantage of me or hurt me, to addiction, to lack, or to depression. I am a child of the Most High God."
