

The word “metamorphosis” comes from the Greek word *metamorphosis* (transformation): *meta* means “after”, while *morphe* means “from”. Paul uses this word in Romans 12:2: “Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed [*metamorphoo*] by the renewing of your mind.” It is God's intent that His children be transformed, or changed, from carnal people to spiritual people. That happens when we focus on the living Word of God, and allow the Holy Spirit to apply it to our life. The Bible is the key to the transformation of the mind.

Are you progressively changing into the image of Christ (Romans 8:29)? The degree of that change correlates directly with the amount of attention you give to the Word of God.

Hebrews 4:12 “For the Word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.”
