For years it looked like it would never happen, but then he heard the prophecy in today's Scripture verse. He was saying: "I have this big mountain in front of me, but it is about to become a molehill." How would it happen? Other translations say by shouting "Grace to it". Another word for "grace" is "favour". He was saying: "Yes, this obstacle is big, but I have the favour of God to overcome and finish this project." He didn't talk about his mountain. He talked to his molehill.

When you face challenges, speak favour over them. Look at your bank account and speak favour to it. Speak favour over your health. Speak favour over your promotion. It is not enough to just pray about it or just believe. What is going to turn the mountain into a molehill is by speaking grace to it.

Zechariah 4:7 "...So, big mountain, who do you think you are? Next to Zerubbabel you are nothing but a molehill. He will proceed to set the Cornerstone in place, accompanied by cheers: Yes! Yes! Do it!"
