

When God gives you a promise, He gives the “Yes”, saying He is going to do it, but that is not enough. You need to add the “Amen” to it, which means you are saying: “I believe it. God, I am in agreement with You.” When He says: “I will bring you to a flourishing finish”, your response should just be three simple words: “Lord, I believe.” When He promises: “I will open the windows of Heaven and pour out blessings that you cannot contain”, don’t say: “I cannot see how that is possible.” You don’t need to see how. Just agree and say: “Lord, I believe.” When He says: “I will restore the years that were stolen from you” don’t go by what you see at the moment. Just add your amen: “Lord, I believe.”

You may think of a hundred reasons why a promise from God is not going to happen. However, there is one great reason why it will happen: The Creator of the Universe has declared it, and He doesn’t go back on His Word.”

2 Corinthians 1:20 “For no matter how many promises God has made, they are “Yes” in Christ. So through Him the “Amen” is spoken by us to the glory of God.”
