

When Moses was a young man, God put the dream in his heart to deliver the Israelites out of slavery. However, he got in a hurry and stepped out of God's timing, killing an Egyptian who was mistreating a Hebrew slave. He spent 40 years on the back side of the desert in hiding. It looked as though that one mistake disqualified him from God's calling. He in all likelihood often thought: "You are a failure. You missed out."
