

Many of the miracles Jesus performed required an act of obedience. When He turned water into wine, He told the staff at the wedding to fill up the large stone pots with water, which didn't make sense. They could have said: "Jesus, we need wine, not water. What good is this going to do?" Without them filling the waterpots, without their obedience, there wouldn't have been a miracle.

Is God asking you to step out in faith into a brand-new venture, to forgive someone who did you wrong, or to pray for others who need healing when you are not feeling well? Is He asking you to fill pots with water when you need wine? It is not so much what you are doing; it is the obedience. God sees your obedience. He sees you believing and stretching forward when you could be discouraged. When you prove to God that you are going to do the right thing even when it is difficult, even when it doesn't make sense, then you are going to see God do amazing things in your life.
