

The apostle Paul was standing before the governor of Judea, a man named Felix, on trial for sharing his faith. Felix was very intrigued by Paul, and as Paul spoke about what it meant to be a believer and how to live a Godly life, Felix felt convicted. He knew he was not living with integrity, and that he needed to stop compromising, but he didn't want to deal with it. Even though he was frightened by the coming judgement, he sent Paul away, saying he would call Paul when he found it "convenient". Two years later, Felix was out of office, and we never read anything more about him. We don't know if a convenient time ever came, or if he ever dealt with what God was bringing to light.

Don't put off what you know God is speaking to you about. On the other side of that obedience is a level of your destiny that you have never seen. No more waiting for a more convenient time. This is your time to activate the power of God in your life by taking action.

Acts 24:25 "As Paul talked about righteousness, self-control and the judgement to come, Felix was afraid and said: 'That is enough for now! You may leave. When I find it convenient, I will send for you.'"
