

In Acts 8, Philip was directed by an angel into the desert to meet the treasurer of the queen of the Ethiopians, who upon hearing about Jesus immediately believed, and wanted to be baptized. When they came up out of the water, the Scripture says that the Holy Spirit of God caught Philip away and he was found in Azotus, where he began preaching again. One moment he was in the water, and the next moment he was twenty miles away. That defies logic, except that God had an obvious purpose for Philip to accomplish quickly.

God has times when He will purposefully propel you ahead. It may not be to another city, but God may propel you in your finances, career, health or a relationship. He opens a door, gives you ideas, causes you to stand out, brings the right people across your path, brings the healing etc. You cannot explain how it happens. It doesn't make sense. It should have taken years. You look up and think: "How did I get to Azotus?" so to speak. Look for the God of acceleration to step in and do what you cannot possibly do.

Acts 8:39-40 "Now when they came up out of the water, the Holy Spirit of the Lord caught Philip away, so that the eunuch saw him no more; and he went on his way rejoicing. Philip was found at Azotus. Passing through, he preached in all the cities until he came to Caesarea."
