

Christians think differently than unbelievers. Paul said: "But we have the mind of Christ". (1 Corinthians 2:16) He told us to "be renewed in the spirit of your mind". (Ephesians 4:23)

When we receive Christ as Saviour, the Holy Spirit begins to refurbish our minds. He takes the words of Scripture and makes them real to us, and real in us. He bears witness with our spirits that we are God's children, and that the sufferings of this world are not worth comparing to our future glory. (Romans 8:18)

The Holy Spirit gives us the ability to face life in a different way. When we encounter a crisis, the Holy Spirit strengthens us with the knowledge of God, which gives us perspective. That provides confidence and strength to see beyond the crisis, and to focus on the Lord.

So if you are facing a difficult situation, ask the Holy Spirit to give you His divine perspective.

Romans 8:16-17 "The Holy Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children, then heirs - heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ, if indeed we suffer with Him, that we may also be glorified together."
